MedSend awarded 28 new grants, 35 renewals for grant recipients signing up for another 4-year term, and 9 new national scholars in this fiscal year. In the midst of the current pandemic, MedSend grant recipients continue to bring hope and healing to a world in need.

Donations for the fiscal year came in at 96% of our need which we consider to be a blessing during this trying time.
