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WHAT WE ARE TEACHING: Breaking News



Kids may not be absorbing the news cycle like adults are, but they are experiencing the news cycle through others around them. It's tough to know what news is helpful and what news is true. This month, kids will have a chance to journey with a few prophets – Micah, Amos, Zephaniah, Ezekiel, and Isaiah – to discover news they can count on. Breaking News will help them develop a strong identity in an ever-changing world. Kids will learn that when things go wrong, they can choose what's right; when they worship God, they can be sincere; when times are tough, they can count on God; when they are lost, God will guide them, and that they can be faithful just like God is faithful.



ACTIVITY:

Micah Says

Tell the kids to stand up with some space between them. The adult leader gives the kids instructions that they must follow (such as touch your head, spin around, jump up high, etc.), but only when the leader starts by saying, "Micah says . . . " If the kids follow an instruction that didn't start with, "Micah says," then they must sit down.

THE BIBLE: Amos 5:18-24


MEMORY VERSE: l Corinthians 16:13

ACTIVITY:

Photo Op

Play an upbeat worship song. Tell the kids to dance, but when the music stops, they freeze in place. While they are "frozen," take pictures as though for a newspaper article. After you have taken pictures, resume the music. Repeat a few times. If possible, you might want to take a few real pictures and print them later with captions and post them in your space.

ACTIVITY:


Listening Lights

Instruct the kids to line up side by side on one end of the room and tell an adult volunteer to stand on the other end. When the adult volunteer says, "Green light," the kids start walking toward the volunteer. However, if the volunteer says, "Red light," the kids must stop walking. If the kids don't listen and are caught, they have to return to the start line.


THE BIBLE: Ezekiel 34:11-16, 20-24

MEMORY VERSE: 1 Corinthians 16:13


ACTIVITY: Follow the Leader

MEMORY VERSE: 1 Corinthians 16:13


ACTIVITY:

Keep the Balloon Up Part 1 and 2:

Part 1: Divide the kids into small groups. Give each group a balloon and encourage them to do their best to keep the balloon up. They can't hit the balloon two times in a row, so they need to rely on their team for help.

Part 2: Just like the activity in the beginning of this lesson, have the kids keep the balloon up in the air as long as possible. Only this time, they are working together as a whole group and have multiple balloons floating at one time.
