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WHAT WE ARE TEACHING: Rise Up



Grab your hiking boots and pitch a tent. It's time to summit through the story of Jesus—who rose from death and gave us everything we need for our journey. This month, we're learning about how the miracle of Jesus' resurrection strengthens us and changes our relationships in the best way. Everyone will have a chance to put these ideas in their backpack to carry with them always: Jesus overcame death. Jesus connects us to each other. Jesus gives encouragement. We are stronger with Jesus.

MEMORY VERSE: Romans 10:9

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9

(point to the sky)

AND BELIEVE IN YOUR HEART

(pat your heart)

(jump with excitement)

THE BIG IDEA: Jesus Overcame Death

THE BIBLE:

Mark 16:1-8

ACTIVITY:

Colorful Cross

Give each kid a piece of black construction paper. Tell them to draw a large cross outline on their paper with a pencil, then go over it using white glue. Next, completely cover the glue design with salt, then shake off the excess salt. You can recycle the excess salt by pouring it back into a container that can be reused for someone else's paper. Have kids dip their paintbrush into watercolor paint and gently touch a part of their design with the brush to have the color spread. You do not have to wait for the glue to dry before painting. Encourage the kids to be gentle so as not to disturb the wet glue under the salt. Leave aside to dry.

THE BIG IDEA: Jesus Connects Us To Each Other

THE BIBLE:

John 20:19-31

ACTIVITY:

Summit Stack

Divide the kids into two to four teams, depending on the size of your group. Create a starting line using painter's tape on the ground, where the teams can line up behind. At the other end of the room, place a long table opposite the lines. Give everyone a plastic cup. When you say, "Go," the teams run one at a time to begin making a cup "mountain," by simply re-stacking the cups upside down one on top of the other. Once one person places a cup, they must run back and tag the next person's hand. The team that stacks all their cups first wins!
