#### STEWARDSHIP: VISION 2020 CAMPAIGN

"Stewardship is effectively managing our resources, personal and church, in accord with God's purpose in our lives. Our annual pledge campaign is an integral part of this process. Pledges provide essential input for our church leadership to plan programs for the coming year; faithful commitment to fulfilling our pledges allows us to complete programs as planned. For 2020 so far, we have received Pledges for \$625,000, exceeding pledges fulfilled for 2019 by 10% for which we are grateful; what a blessing. It is not too late to turn in a pledge card which you can find in the pews or the front office."

To explain a bit more, while our focus is on pledge commitments outstanding, now \$580,000, several have "prepaid" their pledges (i.e. instead of pledging, they simply pre pay it) bringing the total pledged (paid and committed - which is how it is reported and accounted for) amounts for 2020 to \$625,392, rounded to \$625,000.

2020 pledges (paid and committed) at \$625,000 is 10% greater than ACTUAL pledges received for 2019 at \$565,424 (Prepaid at \$43,230 and commitments fulfilled at \$527,104).

So, the "10% better" comparison is pledges made (and prepaid) for 2020 compared to pledges fulfilled for 2019.

Comparing apples to apples; Budgeted Pledges for 2019 at \$655,000 (\$630,000 committed, \$25,000 prepaid) compared to Budgeted Pledges for 2020 is down for 2020 at \$625,392 (\$580,000 committed plus \$45,392 prepaid), a 5% drop.

As of January 20 we are 80% towards our pledge goal of \$603,196. We have commitments for a total of \$479,540 + \$45,200 in prepaid pledges which brings us to the total of \$524,740. Thank you!

Lent is the Christian season of preparation before Easter. The Lenten season is a time when we as Christians observe a period of reflection. prayer, repentance, moderation, self-denial and spiritual discipline. The purpose is to set aside time for reflection on Jesus Christ – His suffering and his sacrifice, His life, death, burial and resurrection.

The significance of the 40-day period (not including Sundays) is based on two episodes of spiritual testing in the Bible: the 40 years in the wilderness wanderings by the Israelites after the exodus from Egypt (Numbers 33:38 and Deuteronomy 1:3) and the Temptation of Jesus after He spent 40 days fasting in the wilderness (Matthew 4:1-11; Mark 1:12-13: Luke 4:1-13

So what does Lent mean to you and how do you intend to use this deep spiritual period as a time of examination and growth in discipleship? What better way than to participate in the many worship and study offerings that we have here at PDCPC during this time.

God clearly calls us to repent and reflect:

- "If my people who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14
- "Repent and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that ٠ times of refreshing may come from the Lord. Acts 3:19
- "For the Lord your God is gracious and compassionate. He will not turn his face from you if you return to him." 2 Chronicles 30:9b
- "Peter said, 'Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Acts 2:38
